Working language: English

Theme: Exploring how Artificial Intelligence can support sustainability, green innovation, and youth-led environmental initiatives.

Funding: 100% Erasmus+ (travel, accommodation, activities)

2. Project Goals & Erasmus+ Priorities

- Develop green skills and environmental awareness among young people through the use of digital and Al tools.
- Explore Artificial Intelligence and creative digital media as tools for eco-advocacy, sustainability projects, and climate change communication.
- Foster intercultural dialogue, inclusion, and teamwork among youth from Armenia and Poland.





3. Expected Learning Outcomes (For YouthPass)

- Digital competence: use Al tools, digital media, and social media to promote sustainability and green solutions.
- Multilingual communication: work in English and practice
 Armenian and Polish phrases.
- Cultural awareness: explore intercultural dialogue, local traditions, and EU values on technology and sustainability.
- Entrepreneurship / initiative: design and run a mini "Green Al" campaign or creative sustainability project.
- Teamwork & collaboration: cooperate in group tasks, debates, and outdoor activities.
- Environmental competence: apply green skills, Al knowledge, and eco-friendly behaviors in daily life.





4. What to Pack

- Passport/ID.
- Warm clothes, waterproof jacket, comfortable shoes.
- Re-usable bottle & tote bag (green rule = no single-use).
- National snacks & small flag for intercultural night.

5. Accommodation & Meals

Participants will stay in shared rooms in a Capital Hotel Tsaghkadzor. Comfortable beds and basic facilities are provided. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided daily. Special dietary needs (vegetarian, vegan, allergies) will be accommodated if informed in advance.





6. TRAVEL AND REIMBURSMENT

Your travel costs will be reimbursed according to the distance bands defined by the Erasmus+ Programme. You'll need to keep and submit all tickets, boarding passes and invoices in order to receive the reimbursement.

Travel must be pre-approved by the host organization. We encourage eco-friendly travel where possible.

The reimbursement will be made by bank transfer after the project, once all original documents are submitted and participation is confirmed.
