Call Local Food Bank – Contact nearby charities to pick up fruits & veggies before they spoil.

Our first solution is to call a local food bank or charity nearby. They already have systems to collect and redistribute food quickly. By contacting them, the fruits and vegetables can be picked up right away and delivered to people in need. This ensures fresh produce doesn't spoil and supports the community at the same time.



Emergency Cooling – Use ice from a gas station to keep produce fresh.

If we are stuck in traffic on a hot day, the food can spoil quickly. A simple solution is to stop at the nearest gas station when possible, buy some ice, and place it near the products. This will lower the temperature and help keep the food fresh until we can move again.



Pop-up “Rescue Market” – Open the truck and let passersby take/buy food at low cost instead of letting it rot.
